Minutes for May 2006 MMGBC meeting were approved by members present as written.

President: New member meeting done last week. ~ 20 new team/Preteam members.

We will be hosting the Level 4/6 State Meet in the spring (Apr 21-22). New board member elections will be at the next meeting. Postings will be in the office for signup. Papst proposed that an assistant to the Treasurer be developed to help handle the load. All present were in favor. A new proposal form was developed for members to fill out and submit for discussion at MMGBC meeting. This will formalize the process of discussing ideas.

Treasurer: Gillett created a job description for the Treasurer & assistant. The mum sale has started. \$3.00 in profit will be made for each pot sold. Gillett is heading this fundraiser. Deliveries planned weekly to the gym. The MMGBC account is ~\$11,000.00 to start the new year. We had ~\$20,100.00 in and ~\$20,044.00 out for the year. A budget will be presented at the annual meeting in September. Meet fees will be set soon based on last years expenses and will be collected in 4 payments Oct-Jan. MMGBC membership fees come out in October.

Fundraising: A list of annual fundraisers will be presented at the annual meeting.

George: Meet season news...Level 4 gymnasts now compete as team. Optional gymnasts will have 7 to 9 competitions. Compulsory gymnasts ~9 competitions & states. Level 4 gymnasts ~ 6 meets. Pre-op ~ 6 meets plus states. Boys will have 9-10 meets. Preteam boys ~ 6 meets. Preteam girls will have 4 or 5 meets. Travel meet considerations this year include Charleston, SC; Las Vegas, NV; Manhattan, NY; Orlando, FL. Team gymnasts will be attending Navy Pier in Chicago and possibly the Cincinnati Cup. George asks that we start a meet planning committee earlier this (this fall) for the State meet we are hosting. This will be discussed at the annual meeting. New leos have been ordered. We will be getting new leos every 2 years. Pre-op program began this past year and will be discussed at annual meeting further by George. The competitive season is starting and George ask parents to take an active role in their gymnasts (i.e. asks questions, etc) Bridgette Symborski has qualified for national competition in September with the TOPS program and will travel to Houston, TX for competition. (WAY TO GO BRIDGETT!)
