All levels will benefit from her but she will be traveling primarily with optionals. She is a former gymnast and coach of Division III collegiate gymnastics. She had a national champion on balance beam as a coach. She holds a degree in exercise/sports science.
- Summer Camps: Olympia in Shelby Township will hold the "Salute to Michigan" day camp July 24-28 for Level 4-elite at a cost of ~\$290.00.
