

**Unapproved Minutes of MMGBC General Meeting

Budget Proposal was presented. It will need to be adjusted if proposals #2 and #3 are passed (see below). Beginning bank balance (8/1/07) \$22,572.55, Membership Personal Account Balances \$1,112.26, MMGBC Account Balance \$14,580.29. Installment toward fundraising for working 2007 meet \$6,880.00.

Information regarding the Silent auction and Dinner fundraiser will be in boxes on Tuesday, September 11, 2007. The event will be held at Swan Valley Country Club on November 3, 2007. Tickets are \$40 each and includes dinner, DJ, silent auction and open bar. Approximately \$10 of each ticket you sell will be credited to your fundraising account. PROPOSALS:

1. Denise McDonald proposed the following changes to compensation for working the MMG hosted meets.
 - Require each family to work 1 session and either set-up or tear down. Each family will receive \$50 credit for this season (2007-2008).
 - Each session worked beyond the requirement will earn 1 credit per session. After meet expenses are finalized each credit will be assigned a dollar amount. The number of credits worked times the dollar amount will equal the amount of money earned toward fundraising for next season (2008-2009).
 - Meet Director earns \$300 credit, Scoring Director earns \$300 credit, all other committee leaders would earn \$100 credit.
 - The only exception would be graduating seniors would have the entire amount earned credited toward this season (2007-2008).

2. George Young: \$600 additional funds for Sports doctor to visit MMG an average of one time per month. This would increase each families fundraising commitment by \$13.00 per year. This proposal will be voted on by the entire membership because it affects the budget. Ballots will be placed in folders by Friday, September 14, 2007.

3. Colette Symborski: \$600 additional funds to pay for George to attend TOPS testing in Texas with Bridget. This would increase each families fundraising commitment \$13.00 per year (this doesn't pay for Bridget but helps defer the cost of flight and hotel for George). This proposal will be voted on by the entire membership because it affects the budget. Ballots will be placed in folders by Friday, September 14, 2007.

Results of voting for proposals 2 and 3 will be announced at the October meeting.

GEORGE'S REPORT: George Young

Travel meet for boys and girls level 5 and up will held in Las Vegas on February 29th, March 1st and 2nd. Any level 4's interested in attending talk to George.

Boy's Team and Pre-team schedules are almost complete and should be out by mid next week.

Fall schedule is going well

October 13 and 14 will be a clinic to review routines and changes. It will be held at Branch Gym in Battle Creek. Levels 5 & 6 attend on Saturday and Levels 7 & 8 attend on Sunday. George would like Gene, Nino, and Rachel to also attend. Cost is \$55 per gymnast and \$35 per coach if registered by 9/14/07. After the 14th the cost is \$65 per gymnast and \$45 per coach. Melissa will post information and sign-up sheet.
